

<u>The Presentation of the Lord - February 2.</u> Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple, 40 days after His birth, to present Him to the Lord as the Law of Moses prescribed. This feast is also known as *Candlemas Day* since the blessing of candles is included in this liturgy.

If you wish to have candles blessed, please bring them with you to Mass, and as part of the liturgy the Priest will bless them.

These blessed candles are to be used in your homes as an expression of your faith in Jesus, the Light of the World who dispels the power of darkness and a reminder that we, too, are called to be bearers of light to the world.
